Evaluating and Citing magazine articles—

Using **EBSCOhost** search for magazine articles on a topic of your choice. You will need to go to EBSCOhost using the S.C. Public Library's site. You will need your library card and your PIN. Once in EBSCOhost use the Advanced Search screen. Your search needs to include at least **2 search terms** (ie. dogs AND training). Find an article in your result list that is **full text**.

1. What does the title of the article tell you about the article? What magazine is the article published in? Are you familiar with this magazine? Write your first impressions of this article below.

2. List two subject terms listed for this article. (These are found at the top part of the article.)

3. If your article is available in [PDF Full Text](#), open up the PDF version of the article. Does your article have any special features such as pictures, tables, graphs or a bibliography? List any special features.

4. Using the **Soquel High School Library Citation Guide** (if you don't know where we keep this, please ask) or <http://webapps.calvin.edu/knightcite/> to write a bibliographic citation for the magazine article you are using. The information that you will need is: the author (if one is listed), the title of the article, the title of the magazine the article was published in, the date the article was published, and the pages of the article. Doing a MLA citation means putting all of the information into a certain form (punctuation is important!). If you were to actually use this magazine for a research paper this is how you would cite it.

5. Now email this article to me at mbritton@sccs.santacruz.k12.ca.us . If you do not have your own email account, please let me know. If you were completing a class assignment you could email the article to yourself and use it later, that way you would not have to print it.
